## **Audacity**

Audacity is free and open source software for recording and editing sound. It is available for Mac OSX, Microsoft Windows, GNU/Linux and other operating systems. As Audacity is a work-in-progress, frequently, new versions are made available for download. Pay close attention to the newest versions as they may not be stable at the time of download.

The best place to go to download a copy of Audacity is <a href="http://audacity.sourceforge.net/">http://audacity.sourceforge.net/</a>. Beware of websites that want you to "join and pay a fee" for Audacity. You can get the same product from its source for free.
